# Rejected Texts & the Reasons for Doing So:

- Moses in Deuteronomy 34:1ff bittersweet reminders of his failures as a leader & Moses <u>died</u> by "God's kiss of death"
- <u>Joshua in Joshua 23:1ff</u>— He reminded Israel of their failures & then he <u>died</u>
- Samuel in 1 Sam. 12 & 25:1— Samuel declared his integrity, fussed at Israel for wanting a king & "Samuel <u>died</u>.

## Reflect With Me on the Fruit of Choices Made— vv.8-12

- 38 Years ago I settled "the Lordship" issue with no apologies & no regrets v.8;
- 38 Years ago I determined His way was better than mine & I have experienced His peace & grace ever since— v.9;
- 38 Years ago I began an adventure that has not lessened in intensity nor diminished in its glory: "to know Him"—

### Reflect With Me on Some of the Realities I've Experienced—vv12-14

- In spite of my obvious flaws, I am graced with a passion to pursue Christ v.12;
- In spite of my failures, by God's grace, I am not a failure. I keep "stretching" forward on my divine journey— v.13;
- In spite of my weaknesses, I am assured of a successful completion of my earthly task—v.14.

# Reflect with Me on My Parting Prayer for You:

- That you would demonstrate the "mind of Christ" in all your decisions— v.15a;
- That you would be patient with those who have not yet experienced "... Christ"— 15b
- That you would establish a "no-backsliding-allowed" rule in your life— v.16a;
- That you would encourage one another by your obvious devotion to Christ & unity of faith— v.16b.
