CHILD PROTECTION WORKSHOP

Our church will host a child protection workshop presented by the Thomas County Baptist Association on Saturday, August 16. Registration will begin at 9:30. The workshop is from 10–12. A light breakfast will be provided. All adults who volunteer with our babies, children and youth need to be here. The workshop will cover the following topics: what constitutes abuse; what are the church's and the pastor's legal reporting requirements; abuse risk management; and implementing safety protocols in the church.



Day 1: Is Jesus Really God's Son?

Evidence: An Eyewitness report (Matthew 3:13-17; John 1:29-36)

John the Baptist was an eyewitness to God's declaration that Jesus, is in fact, His Son. After baptizing Jesus, John shared his eyewitness account about the events surrounding Jesus' baptism.

Day 2:Was Jesus More Than Just a Good Man?

Evidence: Background Check (Mark 6:1-6, 30-56)

Jesus proved He was more than just a good man through the miracles He performed and his teaching. People who knew Jesus' back ground were amazed at His wisdom.

Day 3: Was Jesus' Death Real?

Evidence: Death Confirmed (Mark 14:22-28; 15:22-47)

Jesus foretold His death at the Passover meal. Many witnesses confirmed Jesus' death and the events surrounding His crucifixion and death were recorded.

Day 4: Is Jesus Alive?

Evidence: Physical Proof (Luke 24:1-48)

The evidence proves that Jesus is alive. Angels confirmed the resurrection to the women who came to Jesus' tomb; Peter found an empty tomb and saw only linen clothes. Jesus Himself proved His resurrection by appearing to many.

Day 5: What Do I Do With the Evidence About Jesus?

Evidence: Summing Up the Evidence (Acts 2:14-42; 1 Peter 3:15)

Peter confidently summed up the evidence proving that Jesus is the Messiah. As a result of Peter's testimony, many believed in Jesus.
